INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ACADEMIC CONFERENCE 'THE CHALLENGES OF FUTURE LAWYERS: LEGAL RESPONSIBILITY AND NEW TECHNOLOGIES'

- 1) The Conference organisers accept applications only through this form. The application form should be printed out, filled in, signed in all indicated places and, after scanning, sent back to konferencja.sppka@afm.edu.pl by 15 November 2021.
- 2) The documents sent without the required signatures and not containing an abstract in the form of a separate attachment in a Word format, consisting of maximum 2000 characters including spaces, shall be removed by the organisers and the application to the Conference shall be considered ineffective.
- 3) The information about being qualified to deliver the paper shall be sent by 20 November 2021.
- 4) Paper delivery time should not exceed 15 minutes.
- 5) Participation in the Conference is free of charge.
- 6) The Conference will take place on-line via electronic means of communication (with the use of Zoom platform). The participant acknowledges that in order to take part in the Conference they need to have a computer, smartphone or tablet connected to the Internet and equipped with an inbuilt or external microphone, as well as a webcam.
- 7) The Conference may be recorded by Andrzej Frycz Modrzewski Krakow University.
- 8) By switching on the camera and/or microphone/webcam on their device during the Conference, the participant thereby expresses their consent for their image and voice to be recorded and circulated free of charge by Andrzej Frycz Modrzewski Krakow University in connection with the Conference held. It can be included in informational and promotional materials relating to Andrzej Frycz Modrzewski Krakow University, in press publications, without territorial or time restrictions.
